Our next speaker was born in the UK in 1970. After immigrating to South Africa in 1984, his imagination was sparked by a new and boundless fascination for the natural world. Spiders were hairier, scorpions were plentiful, snakes were more venomous and nature was woven into the fabric of society.

While many have described him as “strange, but in a nice way”, or “the guy you want on speed dial when you get bitten or stung by something”, he describes himself just as the creepy crawly guy who waves the flag for those uncharismatic animals that so many fear, yet few understand.
